Case study: Olympia Textiles changes its maintenance culture with Mainsaver 10.

Textile Spinning: Cotton yarn

A Rs 10billion (2004 assets) cotton yarn manufacturer has recently engaged with MCS for upgrading their computerized maintenance management systems. The work involved moving their data from legacy system under DOS to a new version of Mainsaver and customization of some reports. The business returns calculated present a qualitative value of thousands of rupees, as machines in the autoconer department, under a Reliability REGIME implemented using Mainsaver, have less breakages of thread. A direct impact on quality and hence the selling price was achieved.

Energy/Power Generation Customer:

The Problem: A gas power plant had a critical problem that their inventories would not agree with the accounting department records. Every six months the plant maintenance staff spent over 80 hours with the accounting staff who had to travel from Rawalpindi to reconcile the records.

The Solution: A review was done of the data and as is the case in most CMMS the data was not reliable. MCS developed a routine to calculate the inventory on hand balances from the transactions record to produce a ledger that could be reconciled.

The Result: Staff did not have to travel as before during the year saving traveling costs in thousands of Rupees.
